

**Statement of Work
Fireworks Safety VNR & PSA

1. Description of Services

The Contractor shall provide all necessary personnel, materials, and labor to film, edit and distribute Video News Releases (VNR) and Public Service Announcement (PSA) on fireworks safety.

2. Contract Type

This procurement shall be a fixed price task order under IDIQ contract CPSC-D-15-0012.

3. Description of Work

A. For the Video News Release (VNR), the Contractor shall deliver the following:

1. Produce, edit and distribute a VNR on fireworks safety.
 - a. The contractor shall have an editing/broadcast facility within ten (10) miles of the Washington Mall grounds between the Washington Monument and Capitol Building. Videotaping shall take place on the Washington Mall grounds, the site of the press event.
 - b. The contractor shall produce, market, distribute and evaluate a video product about the Consumer Product Safety Commission's fireworks press event. The contractor shall perform the following:
 - i. The contractor shall develop a shooting plan for the June 30, 2016 press event, which includes shooting footage of the product demonstrations and the CPSC spokesperson's sound bites in a one-on-one style interview style just prior to the morning event.
 - ii. The contractor shall have onsite the equivalent two broadcast-quality cameras and two Go-Pro cameras to get close-up action shots of the demonstrations.
 - iii. Shooting requires the participation of an on-site producer, a camera crew that provides professional lighting, sound quality, and the use of a teleprompter for up to half a day. This project requires that the taping and editing of the package and broadcast occur within one (1) working day. For example, the early morning press event shall be broadcast later in the same day.
 - iv. The contractor shall edit (using AVID/digital editing) the sound bites and cover video into a video of between 30 seconds to 10 minutes in length, depending on its use. The contractor shall develop and write slates (which shall be cleared by CPSC prior to public release) to explain the news

- story. Total editing should take place within the timeframe as described in section biii.
- v. The contractor shall provide the ability to preview the videos using streaming video online to speed approval of updates and changes to the project. The contractor shall be prepared to make any last-minute edits (if necessary) up until the broadcast of the initial satellite feed or posting of the video online.
 - vi. The contractor shall provide advance notification to media, aggressively market the VNR and track media use of the VNR according to the terms of the contract.
- B. For the Public Service Announcement (PSA), the Contractor shall deliver the following:
- 1. Produce, edit and distribute a PSA on fireworks safety.
 - a. The contractor shall develop the script and shooting plan for the video project, edit based on CPSC feedback and prepare final for shoot.
 - b. The Contractor shall obtain access for the film shooting to take place at the Quest Diagnostic Training Facility located at 1925 Giants Drive East Rutherford, New Jersey. The Contractor shall ensure the participation of an on-site producer, a camera crew that provides professional lighting, sound quality, and the use of a teleprompter for up to half a day. Spokespeople for this video will include CPSC Chairman Elliot Kaye and NFL Giants' player Jason Pierre-Paul. Paul has agreed to participate with CPSC in the video without charge to CPSC or the contractor (CACI).
 - c. The contractor shall edit (using AVID/digital editing) the package (public service announcement) video into a video of between 30 seconds to 10 minutes in length, depending on its use. The contractor shall develop and write slates (which shall be cleared by CPSC) to explain the news story. Total editing time is estimated up to twelve (12) hours.
 - d. The contractor shall provide the ability to preview the videos using streaming video online to speed approval of updates and changes to the project. The first draft of the PSA should be delivered by Wednesday, June 15, 2016. The final, CPSC approved PSA should be delivered by 10 a.m. on June 29, 2016. If necessary, the contractor shall be prepared to make any last-minute edits up until the broadcast of the initial satellite feed or posting of the video online.
 - e. The contractor shall provide advance notification to media, aggressively market the PSA and track media use of the PSA according to the terms of the contract.
