SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The meeting was called to order at 1pm by the chair, Mr. Aaron Combs of Bob's Kart Shop. After introductions, last year's meeting minutes were read and motioned for acceptance. The "Provisional Standard Safety Performance Specifications for Fun Karts" has been adopted as an ASTM standard, F2011-00.

Ron Ramon presented the work of the various task groups. The performance group has proposed additional requirements for Sections 4, Fun-Kart Frame and 10, Shield and Guards, for the subcommittee to consider. The Labeling Task Group has developed standard warning label specifications with the appropriate wording and has requested the subcommittee's comments. The group reviewed the proposed labels and CPSC provided comments.

Additionally, there was some discussion among the group regarding the inclusion of the Consumer Use Guideline (F1928-98) with the sale of each Fun-Kart. There are issues of copyright still being discussed with ASTM. The group would like to either settle the matter with ASTM or provide similar type material with the sale of the Fun-Kart.

The group tentatively planned a meeting for early next year with the intention of discussing comments on the proposed labels as well as comments on the changes submitted for the two sections of the standard dealing with the frame and shields and guards.
