SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Representatives from Park-Ohio requested this meeting with CPSC staff to discuss the revised child-resistant packaging test standards and other general questions about the regulations of the Poison Prevention Packaging Act. In addition to the senior test protocol, topics for discussion included misuse of child-resistant packaging by consumers, the relationship between tamper evidence and child-resistance, and the Commission position on dual purpose packaging.

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
