RRK Holdings, Inc./Roto Zip Corporation \$100,000: Civil Penalty Settlement
(Briefing package dated July 28, 2004, OS No. 3694)

DECISION:

The Commission voted 2-1 (with Chairman Stratton dissenting) to provisionally accept a Settlement Agreement and Order, which would order RRK Holdings, Inc./Roto Zip Corporation to pay a civil penalty of \$100,000. The Commission Compliance staff has alleged that RRK Holdings, Inc./Roto Zip Corporation failed to timely report to the Commission that the handles on the spiral saws detached from the tool body while the saw was in use. RRK Holdings, Inc./Roto Zip Corporation violated the reporting requirements of section 15(b) of the Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA), 15 U.S.C. § 2064(b). The failure to furnish information required by section 15(b) is a prohibited act under section 19(a)(4) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2068(a)(4). Section 20(a)(1) of the CPSA, 15 U.S.C. § 2069(a)(1), permits the imposition of civil penalties for any person who knowingly violates section 19 of the CPSA by a company's failure to report information under section 15(b).
