**MINUTES OF COMMISSION MEETING**  
February 16, 2010

Chairman Inez M. Tenenbaum convened the February 16, 2010, 2:00 p.m., meeting of the U. S. Consumer Product Safety Commission in open session. Commissioners Robert S. Adler and Anne M. Northup were present. Commissioners Thomas H. Moore and Nancy A. Nord were not present. Chairman Tenenbaum made opening remarks and invited the staff to begin their briefing.

Unblockable Drains / Public Accommodations – Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act (“VGBPSA”) / Minimum State Requirements for Grants

Barbara Little, General Attorney with the Office of General Counsel, Troy Whitfield, Lead Compliance Officer with the Office of Compliance and Field Operations, and Elizabeth Leland, Economist with the Directorate for Economic Analysis briefed the Commission on the requirements of the VGBPSA as it pertains to unblockable drains, the proposed definition of “Public Accommodations,” the Model Uniform State Pool and Spa Safety Bill (“Model Legislation”), and the implementation of the Section 1405 of the VGBPSA State Grant Program. The staff discussed and responded to questions from the Commissioners.

On the advice of Cheryl Falvey, General Counsel, the meeting went into Executive Session to discuss legal aspects of the VGBPSA.

No decisions were made. There being no further business on the agenda, Chairman Tenenbaum adjourned the meeting at 3:25 p.m.
